Create a top books list with your friends/ team/class, vote, and then read one together.</p> <p>☐ 5. Tell a friend an interesting fact you read in a book that surprised you.</p> <p>☐ 13. Give a book a second chance – revisit something you abandoned before.</p> <p>☐ 14. Ask a friend about the very first book they remember reading.</p> <p>☐ 15. Organise a book swap – share a book you've read with a personal recommendation.</p> | <p>☐ 16. Ask someone what they are currently reading.</p> <p>☐ 17. Read for 15 minutes without checking your phone.</p> <p>☐ 18. Read one chapter of any book.</p> <p>☐ 19.
