| ☐ 3. Cosy evening with a book? Tag @read.forreal on Facebook or Instagram using #readforreal #europeanauthorsday and inspire others with your book choice. | ☐ 18. Read one chapter of any book. |
| ☐ 4. Create a top books list with your friends/team/class, vote, and then read one together. | ☐ 19. Read in a new place (café, park, train, etc.). |
| ☐ 5. Talk about a region or city that interested you based on the description in a book you read or a book whose story takes place there. | ☐ 20. Join or organise a group reading session – a mini reading party! |
